

Hi, firstly thank you guys for the support and kindness and for keeping the military members in mind, it means a lot. My name's Elijah Moser, I'm 22 and in the U.S Air Force. I joined a little over 3 years ago in 2019. I guess I joined because I've always felt it was my duty as an American to serve, and also after high school I wasn't very interested in studying or school anymore. The military was a good way to be productive and develop myself without going straight to college. My job in the Air Force is to be a crew chief, which is the Air Force's way of saying that I'm an aircraft mechanic. I maintain, service, inspect, and fix F-15E's which are a fighter aircraft. I work together with other specialized mechanics to keep the jets airworthy so they can be anywhere and provide airpower at any time. We stay busy because these jets are pretty old and break all the time. But the Air Force still used them because the F-15 is one of our most capable aircraft. This job has taken me to some pretty cool places because wherever we have these jets, we have maintainers there to fix them. I spent my first 2.5 years stationed in England, and for 6 of those months I was deployed to Jordan and UAE in the Middle East. I also made short trips to Poland and Germany during my time in England. I came back to the U.S in June 2022 and now I'm stationed in Idaho. I'll probably be here for a few more years. It's been a crazy journey so far, and not all of it good, but I've gotten a lot of great things out of it. Thank you again for all the support and love everybody sends my way! It's very much appreciated.
