#### A Word Fitly Spoken February 2024

God's voice thunders in marvelous ways; he does great things beyond our understanding. He says to the snow, "Fall on the earth," and to the rain shower, "Be a mighty downpour." So that all men he has made may know his work, he stops every man from his labor. Job 37:5-7

Now it is February, the sad month of the year that almost no one loves. Winter's grip is hard upon both man and beast, and the land lies cold and barren. February is the time for vacations to warmer climes, or looking at seed catalogs to prepare for the coming spring. If we think about anything in February besides Valentine's Day, it is usually the opening line from Shakespeare's play *Richard III: Now is the winter of our discontent*. Many of us would happily trade all of February for a few more weeks of June or July, but our Father in his wisdom gives us winter for our good and benefit. Consider the words from the book of Job at the top of this page.

Elihu, the youngest of Job's four friends, makes this statement as he challenges Job to look beyond his circumstances and see God's hand at work. And we who live thousands of years later, can take lessons for our own benefit today. Rain and snow we all about; we've certainly had plenty of both in 2024 already. But we might ask ourselves exactly how God's voice is speaking to Monocacy Church *in marvelous ways*, because of course he is still speaking to us and in us – are we listening? And considering just the answers to prayer we've seen in recent months, doesn't our Lord *do great things beyond our understanding*? Pause and consider what great things your Savior has done for you, friends – that will be a good spiritual exercise for you this month. And finally, whether it snows or not, take some time to *know all God's work*. Think of what He has done in these last months, the changes in our church life, the new life He is injecting in us, and that is just a small portion of *the great things beyond our understanding*. We can spend a lot of this month being blessed as we think of all His goodness, and giving Him the thanks and praise He deserves!
