Today's Scripture Readings New King James Version (NKJV)

***Call to Worship: Psalm 118:1+19-29**

Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is good!* For His mercy *endures* forever.

Open to me the gates of righteousness;

I will go through them, *And* I will praise the LORD.

²⁰This is the gate of the LORD, through which the righteous shall enter. ²¹I will praise You, for You have answered me, and have become my salvation. ²²The stone *which* the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD's doing; It *is* marvelous in our eyes. ²⁴This *is* the day

the LORD has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. ²⁵Save now, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, I pray, send now prosperity. ²⁶Blessed *is* he who comes in the name of the LORD! We have blessed you from the house of the LORD. ²⁷God *is* the LORD, And He has given us light; Bind the sacrifice with cords to the horns of the altar. ²⁸You *are* my God, and I will praise You; *You are* my God, I will exalt You. ²⁹Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is good!* For His mercy *endures* forever.

***Scripture Reading: Mark 11:1-11**
Now when they drew near Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany, at the Mount of Olives, He sent two of His disciples; ² and He said to them, "Go into the village opposite you; and as soon as you have entered it you will find a colt tied, on which no one has sat. Loose it and bring *it*." ³ And if anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord has need of it,' and immediately he will send it here."⁴ So they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door outside on the street, and they loosed it. ⁵ But some of those who stood there said to them, "What are you doing, loosing the colt?" ⁶ And they spoke to them just as Jesus had commanded. So they let them go. ⁷ Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes on it, and He sat on it. ⁸ And many spread their clothes on the road, and others cut down leafy branches from the trees and spread *them* on the road.
